

## Brief history of the college

Ours is the oldest girl's college in the district of Bankura. The college had its inception in 1973 as a non-govt. private college under the Burdwan University, in order to promote education and culture not only among the young girls of the district, but among those of its adjoining districts as well. The college was venerated with the holy name of Sri Sri Maa Sarada. The objective for naming the college after Her was to preserve Her holy name in the museum of our recollection and follow Her noble ideals with hearts sincere and pure.

Affiliation for admission of students to the General course in the Arts faculty was at first granted by the Burdwan University. Later the college was taken up by the Govt. of West Bengal under "Govt. Sponsored Scheme" with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> June, 1975. At present Honors courses in ten subjects in the Arts stream are going on, which include Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Geography, Political science, History, Philosophy, Education, Music, and Economics. We feel proud to announce that the Science stream in our college has also been introduced in 2006 with Honors in Mathematics. There is also a proposal to introduce Honors in Physics and Chemistry very soon. This could be possible because of the generous Bajoria family of our district, well known locally and internationally for their benevolent deeds, which came forward and shared the major financial responsibility for the benefit of the aspirant students. We also feel proud to announce that the Govt. of India has sanctioned an amount of above Two Crores through RUSA. The State Govt. has sanctioned an amount of Four Lakhs under need based incentive scheme. We owe our gratitude to them for their benison, on behalf of the students and all those who benefit from this institute.

It is worth mentioning that under financial assistance from the State Govt. and from the UGC we have already built five buildings in our campus. We take pride to state that a hostel building is being built in the campus with a special grant of about Rs. One Crore from the UGC in the financial year 2006-07 during the X<sup>th</sup> Plan period. We can jubilate for the open stage, decked with remnants of the culture of 'Raar Bengal', where different cultural functions of the college are held with great pomp and éclat. We have an indoor auditorium with space for nearly 500 guests, and a well equipped Gymnasium for the students. We also rejoice having a modernized, well equipped, and fully air-conditioned seminar hall built with the financial help of RUSA.

Moreover, two PG Course study centers have been running in nine subjects under the Directorate of Distance Education, Rabindra Bharati University, Kolkata, from the year 2006, and DDE of Burdwan University from 2013-14. Last but not the least, the college has been accredited with 'A' grade by the NAAC in 2015. Different activities for smooth running of the college are whole-heartedly taken up by all the staff members, both teaching and non-teaching, and also by the students. To this end co-operation from one and all of Bankura district is earnestly sought by our esteemed institution.

## Online Admission Procedure

I. As per the instruction of the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal, admission will be made through online procedure on stand-alone basis where candidate will have the opportunity of registering her name at the following - [www.saradamanicollegebankura.org](http://www.saradamanicollegebankura.org).

II. She is required to fill up the mandatory fields in the registration form and then click the link of the specific payment portal for making payment of registration fees either through debit/credit card/internet banking to submit the stipulated registration fees of Rs. 150/- (excluding bank charges) through the specific payment gateway.

III. Applicant has to fill separate registration form for either both General and Honors or for any one.

IV. After the registration process is complete the applicant needs to wait for the provisional merit list.

V. After verifying her name in the merit list the applicant is required to deposit the stipulated admission fees followed in the same way as mentioned before. Admission procedure will be completed after verification of all the testimonials and other documents at the end of publication of final merit list, which will be conducted in the college campus.

VI. If any discrepancy is found regarding any document or other details her candidature will be treated as cancelled and her admission fees will be forfeited in total. Applicants will get a chance to review the filled up application form. In case of any mistake she will get chance to fill up another form afresh deleting the previous one.

VII. Students will be admitted purely on the basis of merit in Honors and General Courses.

VIII. Merit lists of all Honors candidates and the dates for counseling will be published in the college web-site according to subject index, which will be prepared on the basis of aggregate and subject marks for honors in Mathematics, Geography, English, Bengali and Sanskrit, whereas for other honors subjects it will be prepared on the basis of aggregate only. For example – if a student gets 400 in aggregate and 80 in the specific subject, then her marks will be counted as 480.

IX. Candidates will not be allowed to take Mathematics, Sanskrit and Geography as combination subjects who did not have those subjects in H.S. Level.

X. Candidates will be allowed to take either Geography or Philosophy, either History or Education, and either Bengali or Sanskrit as combination subjects (for General and Honors both). However, a candidate admitted in Sanskrit Honors will be allowed to take Bengali as combination subject and similarly a candidate, admitted in Bengali Honors will be allowed to take Sanskrit as combination subject.

XI. Students seeking admission in Geography Honors are suggested to take Economics as a combination subject for their own benefit.

XII. Combination subjects cannot be changed for General candidates. Students are suggested to go through the subject dropdown menu carefully before choosing the combination subjects.

XIII. The applicant has to submit Rs.180.00 (by cash) only for practical based General subjects at the time of document verification.

XIV. An advance amount of Rs.500.00 only may be deposited online in favor of hostel seat at the time of admission. However, if the candidate is not selected for a hostel seat the amount deposited will be refunded in total.

## HOSTEL FACILITIES

The girl's hostel can accommodate a total of 159 (one hundred and fifty nine) students – old and new hostel taken together. Students belonging to Scheduled Castes & Tribes are allotted seats as per Government rules. Seats are filled purely on the basis of merit. The boarders are required to follow the hostel rules strictly and to clear all the dues in time.

Seat rent for hostel accommodation has to be paid for 12 months. The hostel is officially closed during the Puja Vacation, and remains open during the Summer Recess to enable the students to appear for the University Examinations.

## **LIBRARY**

We have a well equipped, fully computerized Digital library with more than 26,000 volumes of books for the students. Books on demand for reading are available in the Students' Reading Room, or they may be borrowed for home study. The college is a subscriber to both national and international monthly journals and magazines on various subjects. Both English and Bengali daily newspapers are available in the Library Reading Room. Students may borrow books from the Departmental Book-Banks as well against a caution deposit as admissible by the authority.

## **LABORATORY**

The Geography department has a fully fledged, good and up to the mark laboratory, and though the science faculty has been newly established, it has fairly adequate laboratories for use of the students of the Physics and Chemistry departments.

## **NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME**

The college has three NSS wings run by very efficient teachers, where the students get the opportunity to participate in community service. It helps in developing their persona through enriched experiences and builds a positive social awareness. All the units organize various program throughout the year, like blood donation camps, health camps etc. Health check-up facilities are available through the NSS as scheduled by the authority. Though participation in the scheme is optional for the students, it is desirably recommended for building their holistic attitude.

## **OTHER FACILITIES**

The students' Aid Fund is a need-based support service for the economically backward students, which provides aid for filling up forms at the time of University examinations. Incentives are given to state level student participants in the field of sports at the discretion of the college authority. Besides this, the students can avail themselves of Computer and Xerox facilities. There is a canteen inside the college campus, which provides fresh and healthy food for the students. In order to supply fresh and purified drinking water the students' room has been equipped with an aqua-guard water purifier, and there are two purified drinking water-cooler as well in the campus.

## **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

Various competitions like debate, recitation, extempore speech, music and quiz competitions are held for the students every year. Cultural programs like Freshers' Welcome, Annual Social Function etc. are also organized to help create a culture-friendly atmosphere in the campus. The teaching and non-teaching staff together enlivens all the programs with their presence and inspiration as well. The college holds Annual Sports with various events to encourage students' participation in physical activities, where participation from the ex-students is also encouraged, because as Swamiji said that, a healthy mind resides only in a healthy body.

## **SEMINARS**

The college frequently organizes State level as well as National level academic seminars and other cultural programs like Departmental Exhibitions, where the students' participation adds to the splendor.
